

AGILITY KEY CLUB POLICY

Key Club is one of the many benefits of being an OCC Member. Regular Members (Individual or Household) may join key club and use our building for the cost of \$5.00/hour per member or 1 hour of volunteer time. Key Club members may invite Associate members to accompany them as their guests. Each guest must sign in and pay the \$5/hour club dues or use volunteer hours. All Key Club members and their guests must be members in good standing. Their dogs must be registered with the club and have current shot records on our website. All Key Club members and guests must sign in each time they use the Agility Field. The sign-in sheet and payment envelope are in the Agility shed. Please be sure to include your name and "Key Club" on all payments. Agility key club members should join the Agility Facebook page, "Agility at OCC". On this page you must post the day and time you wish to reserve the field. Reservations are a maximum of two consecutive hours. Any classes or OCC scheduled events take precedence over private practice time.

Key Club may be utilized when there is a class at the same time with the instructor's pre-approval. Please disclose the exact nature of your activity when seeking permission to be in the building at the same time as a scheduled class. The building may not be shared during activities such as Fair Play, Reactivity, or Virtual Trialing.

Key Club - Agility Field Protocol

- Remember to sign in and pay key club dues 1 volunteer hour or \$5.00/ hour.
- If you are training alone, you must indicate on the sign in sheet the name of someone you have called, emailed, or texted that you are on the field and that you have also let the person know when you are leaving the premises.
- If barn swallows are nesting, make sure that no equipment is under birds' nests.
- Use only flat or rolled collars (no choke collars, pinch collars, or training collars).
- Dogs that are not running must be in crates. Dogs should not be tethered to equipment or building structures.
- Do not allow your dog to eliminate in any part of the fenced agility area (field or grass). If your dog does eliminate on the field please use the spray solution to clean the area.
- Turn down the ends of the tunnels and rake field after use.
- Be sure that no part of any hose is laying on the grass around the field.
- Remove all personal items and garbage from the field and shed before you leave.
- Lock the padlock when you leave.
