




# Seven Simple Steps!



The Obedience Club of Chattanooga (OCC) adopts the following membership process and requirements for becoming a voting member (Individual and Household):

1. The voting member candidate/s must attend at least one OCC session. (at least signed up for class)
  2. Both paper or online membership applications are accepted by OCC.
  3. Member-candidates must agree to follow OCC and AKC rules and policies (part of application)
  4. The candidate will be communicated to OCC Members before or at the next membership meeting.
  5. Voting candidates are only fully accepted as a member once their membership dues are paid and voted in during a membership meeting.
  6. Membership candidates are accepted by vote at club meetings according to OCC bylaws.
  7. New members will receive communication (eg, email) notifying of their acceptance.
